IMPROVEMENTS TO YOUR HOME?

In the Cross Creek Ranch Community Association, all exterior modifications to your home are to be approved by the Design Review Committee (DRC) according to the Design Guidelines and Community Rules.

In order for the DRC to review, you must complete the Home Improvement Request Form for the modifications located on the website. You may submit the application only by logging into the Resident Intranet and selecting "Home Improvement Application".

Before you begin, take a moment to gather all the information about your project, including any attachments you will need to upload.

- Select the Home Improvement Type you will need to know, the entire scope of your project.
- You will have the opportunity to submit more than 1 request at the end of this process.
- If you are submitting more than one type of improvement, please enter each separately.
- This application will consist of a varying number of questions based on the type of improvement selected. Please allow approximately 30 minutes to complete the application in its entirety
- Applications in progress will not be saved.
- Your form is not officially submitted until you have completed all 6 sections and hit the submit button on the last step.
- You will receive a confirmation once your application is officially accepted.

looking forward to the opportunity to learn, experience growth, and connect with others through the realm of health & fitness here at Cross Creek Ranch.





Monthly Recipe FROM ITALIAN MAIL CAFÉ

ITALIAN PIZZELLES

I've tried different pizzelle recipes, but my mom's is still the best! If you're lucky to have a pizzelle iron, give her recipe a try.

11/2 Cups flour • 3 jumbo eggs • Cups sugar • 1 stick butter melted and cooled • 1 t. baking powder
• 1 t. vanilla extract • 1 t. anise extract • 1 t. orange juice • 1 t. lemon juice

Preheat pizzelle iron. Mix flour and baking powder. Set aside. Beat eggs with sugar. Add vanilla, anise, orange juice lemon juice, and cooled melted butter. Slowly add flour and baking powder mixture. Drop tablespoons of the batter onto pizzelle maker. Close and lock pizzelle iron. Cook for about 30 seconds. Remove pizzelles from iron. Place on a cookie rack to cool. Dust with powdered sugar. Enjoy!

LOAM CSA PROGRAM

The CSA is a weekly share of locally, sustainably grown produce delivered to you, and grown here in Fort Bend County. Members sign up online at Loamagronomics.com for a weekly share of seasonal produce and it's delivered to the community room here at CCR. It's \$30 a week, with weekly recurring payments. Each box contains 8-10 varieties of nutritious, delicious produce. This program is an intimate relationship between the community and the farmer. You will receive a weekly newsletter telling you what's in your box, current events at the farm, storage techniques, member in residence blog, recipes curated by local chefs and invites to member events on our farm. If you are going out of town on vacation or can't pick up your box for whatever reason you can simply login to your account and put your share on hold. It's very flexible, and user friendly. Why register? Not only are you providing your family with a nutrient rich, delicious box of produce, but you are also supporting the growing local food movement in our region. Plus, you'll receive the convenience of having the farm share delivered right here to CCR!

MASTER NATURALIST PROGRAM REDUCING YOUR PLASTIC FOOTPRINT: STRAWS ARE OPTIONAL

Thursday, March 7 • 6:30 PM social, 7 PM program • Rosenberg Civic Center, 3825 Texas 36 South, Rosenberg Natalie Joliecoeur, Manager Member Relat ions and Conservation Action Specialist for the Houston Zoo, describes how the Zoo has over several years eliminated many plastic items, particularly single-use bottles, bags and straws, adopted alternatives to plastic. She talks about staff successes in reducing plastic in their day to day processes, as well as some of the local projects they created.

Chapter Program Vice President, Debby Wendt and State Representative, Andrea Morgenstern will demonstrate the serious impact of plastic waste on the land and ocean environments. They will suggest ways we as individuals can reduce plastic use and pollution.

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

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
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
