TEXAS HERITAGE PARKWAY- GET IN THE LOOP!

The long awaited Texas Heritage Parkway is expected to open very soon. It will be a great addition to our mobility from the community to I-10. There will be no stop signs or lights, but there will be roundabout intersections. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with this type of intersection, if you aren't familiar already.

The Texas Heritage Parkway corridor has been engineered to provide enhanced safety and operations at the major intersections. The roundabouts built along Texas Heritage Parkway have an expected design life well beyond year 2040. Please help the THPID to spread roundabout awareness and education by sharing a link to this webpage, following the keys to success driving a roundabout, and engaging others in the community regarding driver safety and awareness.

Roundabouts are termed a "proven safety countermeasure" by the Federal Highway Administration Office of Safety. Due to the reduction of fatal and injury crashes at roundabouts, compared to conventional intersections, these types of intersections are gaining popularity in the United States. Over the past 25 years there have been over 7,000 roundabouts built in the United States. In Texas there are over 300 roundabouts that have been built over the past 20 years.



KEYS TO SUCCESS DRIVING A ROUNDABOUT

- Choose your appropriate lane well in advance of the roundabout intersection. For left turns and thru movements, position your vehicle within the inside (left) lane along Texas Heritage Parkway. For right turns and thru movements, position your vehicle within the outside (right) lane. This is called ultimate lane assignment and helps to mitigate the issues that arise when drivers try to make last-minute lane changes near an intersection.
- Slow your vehicle to a comfortable speed, typically 10mph-15mph, prior to the roundabout.
- Pay attention for bicyclists and pedestrians that may be crossing at the crosswalk prior to the entry of the roundabout and especially for on-street bicyclists.
- Look to your left for oncoming circulating/conflicting traffic already in the roundabout. As a motorist you need to yield to other traffic that is already present within the roundabout. This includes yielding to both lanes if the roundabout has two circulating lanes to the left of your entrance to the roundabout.
- Enter the roundabout only when there is a safe and adequate gap in traffic. Roundabouts are not intended to operate under a "merge" condition like an interstate ramp.
- Remain in your respective lane within the roundabout. If you have chosen your lane correctly in advance you should not need to change lanes once within the roundabout. The lane will guide you to your respective exit.
- Just prior to exiting the roundabout, signal with your right turn blinker and pay attention for pedestrians that may be crossing the roadway just beyond the roundabout.
- Yield to pedestrians that are within the crosswalk just beyond the roundabout.
- Once beyond the crosswalk, resume the posted speed.

HOW TO ACCESS Amenities

The new Cross Creek Ranch Amenity Access and Gate Entry System is live now! This will allow you to access amenities with your smartphone or key fob.

Your mobile credential app is not linked to the My Cross Creek Ranch App, but through an app called "Conekt".



Step 1: REQUEST ACCESS ONLINE

CROSS CREEK

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Once you complete the Amenity Access form online, (either through CIA Services website or the CCR app) you will receive an email confirmation that your request has been received. A separate email will be sent with your amenity access information with instructions on how to proceed. **TIP: Check your spam folder for the email**.

NOTE: While you await your confirmation for amenity access, make sure to request your Resident Login on the CCR app. It can be found in the app store or Google Play Store. You can also access the web version of the app by visiting www.MyCCRanch.com.





Step 2: GETTHE APP

(Skip this step if you requested only a key fob) When you receive your amenity access information email you will use your 16 digit code or QR code within the attachment to upload your mobile credential to the **CONEKT** app.

Note: once you upload your mobile credential, your mobile device is active! If you did not request a mobile credential, you are not required to download this app. If you requested a key fob please allow time for the postal service to deliver your device.





Step 3: ACCESS YOUR AMENITIES

You will be able to use your smartphone (once you have downloaded and connected your credentials to the **CONEKT** app) or key fob to scan in with the device reader.

Once you have a Resident Login on the CCR app, here is how it works.





STEP 1:

In your community app, go to COVID-19 Amenity Pass. You will be prompted to sign the waiver and release - after you confirm your email you will be redirected to step 2.

STEP 2:

View the available timeslots for the desired amenity and select the timeslot card that you wish to schedule. Once you've identified the correct timeslot, request your pass and indicate the number of individuals in your party.

Once you have completed this process, you will receive an email confirmation, push notification, and your amenity passes will be available to you on the home feed of the app.

HOW TO USE YOUR PASS

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10 minutes prior to the beginning of your start time, you will receive a push notification reminder^{*} to your device.

10 mins prior to your end time, you will receive a push notification asking you to prepare to leave the amenity.

At the expiration of your amenity pass, please exit the amenity in preparation for the next group of residents.

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
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
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


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MY CCR APP REMINDER
