# **HOA** CORNER

## — KEEP YOUR BACKYARD BUG-FREE — *Naturally*

Summer is the time for barbecue parties and sleeping under the stars, but bothersome bugs can ruin outdoor fun! Here are a few tips to help you enjoy a bug-free summer.

- Wet and wild. Eliminate stagnated or standing water in your yard; it provides breeding grounds for mosquitoes. Emptying used kiddy pools and fountains and refilling them with fresh water, cleaning gutters of leaves and other rain-blocking debris, and filling in puddles with dirt are just some of the ways to reduce the buzzing bugs in your yard.
- **Going to the birds.** Setting up a birdhouse in your yard is not only a great way to enjoy the beauty of our feathered friends, but it also mitigates bug problems since many birds love to dine on dragonflies, dung beetles, and the ilk.
- **Candle in the wind.** When outdoors, ignite an all-natural bug-repellant candle nearby to keep the bugs at bay, and enjoy the sweet smell of citronella, lavender, mint, and other aromas that pests find repugnant. Brands such as BioSensory, Solay, Melo, and Yankee Candle have jumped onto the debugging bandwagon and offer eco-conscious candles.
- Light up the night. Many high-flying insects are drawn to light like a moth to the...you get the idea. So, why not install an elevated yellow bug light on your back porch or deck to attract those critters up and away from the ground (and you!) when you spend an evening outdoors? Of course, be sure to review our CC&Rs or talk with an association representative to make sure your bug lights are in compliance with our rules.

#### Rodent Problems? CONTACT YOUR PEST/RODENT CONTROL PROFESSIONALS!

Living in a wooded or nature-focused community can certainly compound pest-related issues. The beautifully restored natural areas, wooded trails, lakes, and ponds are all key parts of what makes Cross Creek Ranch the nature-hood! We are aware of an increase in nutria rodent sightings in the community. As part of the routine landscape maintenance in Cross Creek Ranch, tall grass areas are cut back to between 12 and 18 inches to promote health and also reduce habitability for these rodents. We are currently in the middle of community-wide cutbacks for native tall grasses in areas throughout the community and expect to see an increase in the nutria rodent sightings as a result. As we manipulate their current habitats, they emerge seeking new ones.

Once the cutbacks have been completed, you will likely see fewer nutria rodents throughout the community. If you are experiencing an increase in nutria rodent activity near your home, we encourage you to have your home pest control company make recommendations on how you can prevent or control the nutria rodents from accessing your home.

# — CROSS CREEK RANCH — Wildlife Showcased in New Book



(Fulshear, TX - May 11, 2023)—The abundant wildlife found throughout Cross Creek Ranch has found a new home — between the pages of a photography book created by residents of the master-planned community.

The new book, "Fulshear and Beyond - Wildlife of Southeast Texas" is the result of hundreds of hours behind the camera by residents Paul Broussard, Keith Turpin, Raymond Choo and David Hollier.

Thirty percent of the photographs in the book were taken in Cross Creek Ranch. The rest are from nearby spots throughout Southeast Texas.

"Cross Creek Ranch planners kept nature habitats in mind when they planned the development," said Paul Broussard. "The many lakes, Polishing Pond, trails along Flewellen Creek and layout of the neighborhoods allow wildlife to co-exist with Cross Creek Ranch residents."

It was the required isolation of Covid that had the photographers looking more closely at the wildlife in their own backyard.

'The pandemic is what brought me back around to spending more time in the outdoors," said Keith Turpin. "I was looking for something interesting to do and that is when I picked up my cameras and dusted them off after they had sat unused for a few years."

Broussard has been shooting wildlife since he retired in 2019.

"My background in photography is what I might call an advanced amateur status," Broussard said. "I have an RV that I use to go to state parks to take wildlife pictures during migration times. I am in my truck at least once a week looking to take some nature shots around the area."

The men began posting their work on social media. Soon after, friends and family suggested they publish a book. Each photographer contributed their favorite photographs.

"A few of my favorite photos are the soaring Short Eared Owl, the resting bobcat, the brightly colored Painted Bunting, the approaching alligator, or the dancing squirrel," Turpin said. "We actually have a page at the end of the book where we listed out our favorite local areas to go for wildlife photography."

Broussard's favorites include the photos of birds he took, including an eagle, White-faced Ibis, and mourning doves.

Both Turpin and Broussard hope the book helps give people an appreciation for nature.

"What I hope is that the people enjoy the pictures and diversity of wildlife here in Cross Creek Ranch and the surrounding areas," Broussard said. "Secondly, that families can enjoy them together and the children are able to put a name to the wildlife they encounter in our area."


#### National Bingo Day

# HOW TO ACCESS Amenities

CROSS CREEK

RANCH

The new Cross Creek Ranch Amenity Access and Gate Entry System is live now! This will allow you to access amenities with your smartphone or key fob.

Your mobile credential app is not linked to the My Cross Creek App, but through an app called "Conekt".



# Step 1: REQUEST ACCESS ONLINE

Once you complete the Amenity Access form online, (either through CIA Services website or the CCR app) you will receive an email confirmation that your request has been received. A separate email will be sent with your amenity access information with instructions on how to proceed. **TIP: Check your spam folder for the email.**

NOTE: While you await your confirmation for amenity access, make sure to request your Resident Login on the CCR app. It can be found in the app store or Google Play Store. You can also access the web version of the app by visiting www.MyCCRanch.com.

## Step 2: GETTHEAPP

(Skip this step if you requested only a key fob) When you receive your amenity access information email you will use your 16 digit code or QR code within the attachment to upload your mobile credential to the **CONEKT** app.

**Note:** once you upload your mobile credential, your mobile device is active! If you did not request a mobile credential, you are not required to download this app. If you requested a key fob please allow time for the postal service to deliver your device.





# Step 3: ACCESS YOUR AMENITIES

You will be able to use your smartphone (once you have downloaded and connected your credentials to the **CONEKT** app) or key fob to scan in with the device reader.
